

"SIT-COM FLASHBACK TO THE 70'S/80'S/90'S"

Thank you for your interest in the Miss Old Street Pageant. We pride ourselves in having a fair and straight forward contest. This year's pageant will be held on Saturday, September 27, 2025. The theme is "Sit-Com Flashback to the 70's/80's/90's"

In keeping with fair competition, some rules and regulations apply:

- 1. Registration will be from 4:00 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. No one arriving after this time will be permitted to enter.
 - a. Contestants may pre-register Starting September 1, 2025.
 - b. Registration may be extended at the bar's discretion due to act of God or any other reason.
 - c. Pre-registrants must be present at closing of registration
 - i. If registrant is not present, they will not be allowed to compete and registration fee is forfeited.
- 2. Entry fee is \$75.00; cash only and must accompany the application.
 - a. Pre-registration fee is \$65.00. (\$10.00 discount)
 - i. Early registration fee must be paid in advance, saying you're doing the pageant doesn't qualify for the discount.
- 3. Contestants must be back at Old Street no later than 8:00 p.m.
 - a. Any contestant arriving after 8:00 p.m. will have 4 points deducted from their final score.
- 4. Use of fire, water, glitter or confetti during the competition is strictly prohibited.
- 5. Presentation is limited to 3 minutes maximum. Presentation may be "standard" style presentation or performed.
- 6. Talent numbers are limited to 7 minutes or less.
 - a. There is a deduction of 3 points for exceeding time limits.
- 7. You will be given 5 minutes total for prop setup/tear-down in each category.
 - a. There is a deduction of 3 points for exceeding time limits.
- 8. Old Street Saloon and staff will not tolerate the use of any drugs or abuse of alcohol while on the premises.
- 9. Theft of any kind will not be tolerated and will be prosecuted.
- 10. No monies will be refunded at any time; i.e. after disqualification or for personal withdrawal from the pageant.
- 11. Each contestant is allowed one dresser and they must pay to enter the club. All backup performers must pay to enter the club.
- 12. Only the contestant and dresser are to be in the dressing area.
 - a. Backup performers may enter briefly to change and immediately exit.
 - b. Violation is cause for five (5) point deduction or disqualification.
- 13. No food or drink is permitted in the dressing room area. Water with lid is acceptable.
- 14. All contestants must be male at birth and not fully transitioned.
- 15. Contestants are not to accept tips, to do so will result in disqualification.



- 16. If you have a problem, disagree with the outcome of the pageant or have a complaint, you may speak with the pageant coordinator and review the judges' score sheets. Please handle yourself in a professional manner.
- 17. The winner MUST participate in one benefit show that is sponsored by the club.
- 18. The winner shall not compete for another bar title during their reign.
- 19. Prizes
 - a. Winner Prize package:
 - i. The winner will be given the title of Miss Old Street and will hold the title until the crowning of the next Miss Old Street the following year
 - ii. A crown will be awarded
 - iii. \$200.00 will be awarded in two payments; \$100.00 at crowning and \$100.00 at completion of your year
 - iv. The winner is entitled to one paid booking a month at Old Street Saloon; booking will be paid at the end the booking night.
 - 1. It is an expectation of the winner, when booked, to be ready and mingling with the crowd at least one hour prior to showtime.
 - v. The winner may hold one benefit for themselves at the club.
 - b. First Runner-Up Prize package:
 - i. \$75.00
 - ii. Four show bookings within the next year
 - iii. The runner-up will assume the title of Miss Old Street should the reigning Miss Old Street be unable to fulfill the obligations.
 - c. In the event of a tie, the prize for the level will be split/shared between the contestants that tied.
- 20. Categories/Scoring
 - a. A comparative scoring system is used.
 - b. No two contestants can receive the same score from any one judge.
 - c. Theme will only be judged during presentation.
 - d. Categories
 - i. Presentation—Worth 20-2 points
 - ii. Creative Evening Wear—Worth 20-2 points
 - iii. On-Stage Question—Worth 20-2 points
 - iv. Talent—Worth 40-4 points
- 21. Revocation of title/bookings
 - a. The Club Management/Owner may revoke title at their discretion, at any time.
 - b. The Club Management/Owner may revoke award prize package and show bookings.
 - c. Crown and sash must be surrendered immediately upon revocation notification.
